



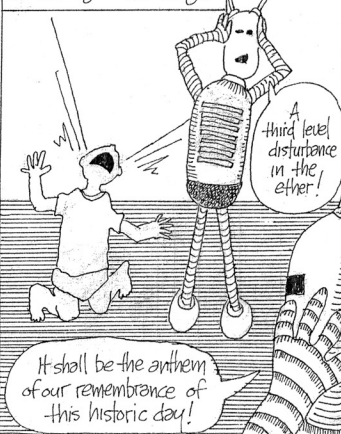
Back in Issue #18 (Tom Not-So-Swift and his invisible Prophylactic), we learned of certain inadvertent consequences of "bugs" in his device.

One consequence is now six months old, and must use all his pluck and ingenuity due to...

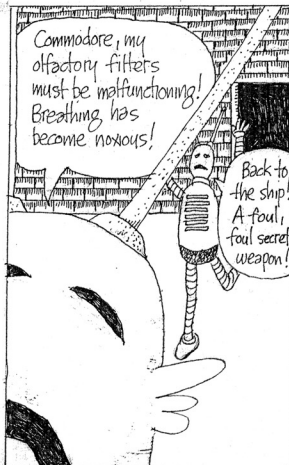
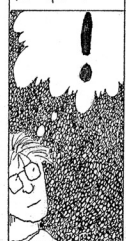

and the frightful Dr. Wagh.



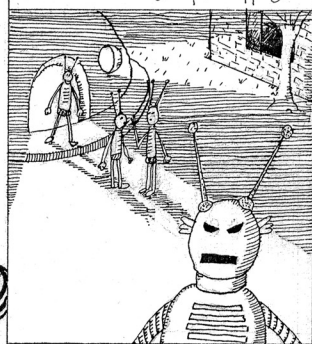
Dismayed that his devices did not succeed, Tom Jr. falls back on his "ace in the hole," with predictable results....

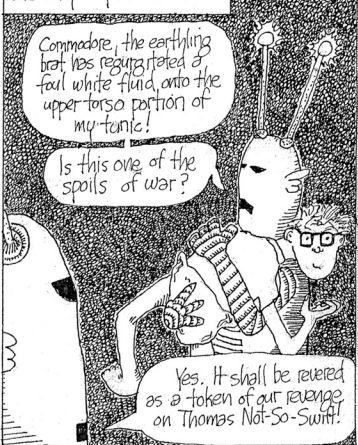
